PART 1 - GENERAL

1.01 NEA BOARD OF REALTORS - BUILDING RENOVATION

- A. The NEA Board of Realtors is requesting **SEALED** proposals from Qualified Licensed General Contractors for the furnishing of materials, labor, equipment, tools, accessories, and supervision necessary for completing the above referenced project.
- B. SEALED Proposals for Office Building renovation, 912 Congress Circle, will be received by Jamey McFadden (Architect) on behalf of the Board of Realtors, Jonesboro, Arkansas, hereinafter termed Owner, until 4:00 p.m. local time, December 16, in the Second Floor Conference Room, located in the Century Center Building, 301 W. Washington Ave, Jonesboro, Arkansas, where the **Proposals will be opened and read privately**. There will be only one proposal for the entire project.
- C. Proposals shall be submitted on the form provided by the Architect and be delivered in a sealed opaque envelope clearly identifying the Project Name, Bidder's name, Bidder's address, and Bidder's current Arkansas Contractor's license number on the front. Bids may be delivered at the Bid opening location, or be mailed to: Attn: Jamey McFadden, 301 West Washington Ave, Suite 200, Jonesboro, Arkansas 72401. Bids not received by the Bid time and date listed above will not be accepted and will be returned unopened.
- D. Bidder must be properly licensed as a current General Contractor by the State of Arkansas at the time of Bid Opening.
- E. Bids will be based on a single lump sum basis for the entire project.
- F. Scope of work includes: Exterior walls and roof to remain. Existing building to receive a new metal canopy at south entrance and new sunshade devices installed above two windows. Existing brick facade will be painted. The building will receive a manufactured stone veneer wainscot on three sides. No additional square feet will be added to the existing building. Interior work includes some demolition and reconfiguration of the rooms layout and add finishes to a currently unfinished space. Work includes HVAC, plumbing, and electrical.
